MAY MEETING PREVIEW

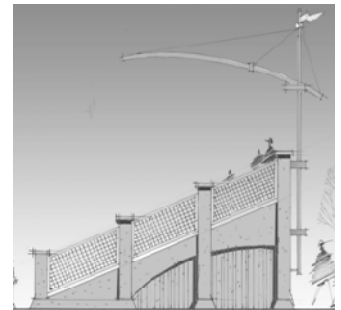
Tuesday, May 26, 7PM at Houghton Fire Station #22
